All instructions during the week are **as Gaeilge** so everyone has a fabulous opportunity to hear and practice speaking Irish. As we know, the best way to learn a language is to immerse yourself in it and to *live it*.

You will have an exciting week meeting lots of new friends, trying out new experiences and challenges, participating in games and activities, tours and trips, learning new dances, enjoying 'the craic' and generally having an excellent time.

10.00am – 1.00pm Morning language classes take place with an emphasis on simple everyday conversational Irish. We aim to build confidence, teach vocabulary and construct simple sentences with lots of fun and storytelling. Classes are very enjoyable.
